## ENGLISH

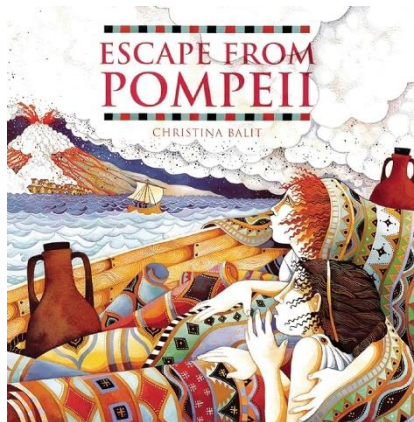
This term we will be writing fact files, persuasive letters and narratives based on the story 'Escape from Pompeii' by Christina Balit. We will be supporting this with adverbs as well as focusing on structural features to organise our writing.

## MATHS

In Maths, we will be doing some more work on multiplication and division looking at ways to easily solve multiplication and division problems. We will then move onto our unit on length and perimeter. This will begin by looking at using a ruler correctly to measure and then using this to calculate perimeters.

## SCIENCE

In Science, we will be learning about the rocks and the formation of fossils. We will analyse and categorise rocks as well as looking at Mary Anning, the mother of paleontology.



## HUMANITIES

In History this term, we are learning about the Romans. We will analyse the impact the Romans had on Britain including roman soldiers, Hadrian's Wall and Boudicca.

## RE

In R.E. this term we will be looking at prayer and its importance. It will look at a variety of religions, the practice of praying and the religious and spiritual significance of it.
