ENGLISH

Our text this term is *Ariki and the Giant Shark* by Nicola Davies.

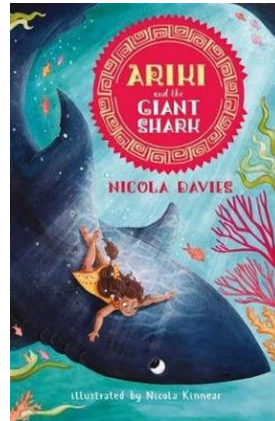
Whilst exploring the text the children will have an opportunity to write diary entry as if they were Ariki and write explanation pieces based on the text.

MATHS

During the first week, we will be learning about measurement with the focus on area. However, the main focus this term is on multiplication and division. The children will be focusing on the 3, 6, 9, 7 and 12 times tables. We will be revising the times tables as well as understanding how division facts are related to multiplication facts.

SCIENCE

In our science this term, we will be learning about Animals including humans. Children will look at the digestive system and what happens to our food when we eat it. They will learn about the different teeth we have and what their functions are.



HUMANITIES

In Geography we will be deepening our understanding of where our water comes from as we learn about the water cycle. We will learn about water pollution and what we can do to reduce pollution in the water.

RE

Why are festivals important to religious communities? Children will have opportunity to explore different religious festivals and compare festivals within Christianity and other faiths.

Computing
