ENGLISH

We will be focussing on our class core text, *The Viewer* by Gary Crew & Shaun Tan.

As the children explore the text, they will then write a diary entry and a narrative story building suspense.

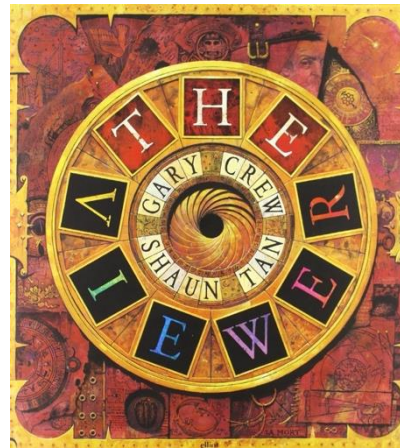
MATHS

This term our focus will be on fractions.

This will build on the children's prior knowledge of multiplication and division, as they will be adding, subtracting and multiplying fractions. They will also be finding equivalents and fractions of an amount.

SCIENCE

Our focus is on Evolution & Inheritance. This will lead us to looking at fossils, how cactuses have adapted to their environment in addition to learning about the the work of Charles Darwin.



HUMANITIES

Our key learning will be based on Mayan Civilisation. This will focus on the how the civilisation functioned & was structured, what they believed & how it influenced them, as well as sequencing our chronological understanding.

RE

We will be looking at the question: "Is it better to express your religion in arts or architecture or in charity and generosity?" We will look at a variety of different religions in order to fully answer.

ART & DESIGN

We will be assessing famous sculptors and looking at some of their famous pieces. We will then create our own totem poles, taking influence from the Mayan civilisation we have learnt about.

COMPUTING

We will be looking at programming this term. Utilising the online learning platform *Scratch*, the children will create their own games looking at variables.
